# 2019 Deep South & Tenarky District Horticultural Schedule

Franklin, TN – October 5, 2019

The grooming area will open at **1:00 AM**. Exhibitors will place their own entries from **6:00 AM** until **9:30 AM** being careful not to touch or move another entry. Rose Show personnel will be available to assist exhibitors as needed. Challenge Class Entries will be assigned space by a lottery drawing. Challenge Class Entries are not to be touched by anyone except the entrant.

Cash Prizes, Trophies, Certificates and Ribbons (if desired) may be picked up Saturday, October 5, 2019 at **4:00 PM** in the hallway in front of the rose show. Prizes and Certificates for all District Queens will be presented at the Awards Banquet Saturday evening, October 5, 2019.

## RULES

1. ARS **Deep South** and **Tenarky** District Challenge Classes are open only to ARS members who are members of the Deep South District or the Tenarky District respectively and who are registered for this convention. Deep South District members may not exhibit in Tenarky District Challenge Classes and Tenarky District members may not exhibit in Deep South District Challenge Classes. Non Deep South and non Tenarky District members may not exhibit in these classes. All other District classes are open to all exhibitors who are registered for this convention.
2. Entries are judged by ARS accredited and/or ARS apprentice judges according to ARS Guidelines and Rules for Judging Roses and other show conditions as set forth in this Rose Show Schedule. Only Blue Ribbon Winners are eligible for Awards and/or Prizes. The point scale at the bottom of the Rose Show Rules will be incorporated into the judging of the roses in accordance to ARS Rules and Regulations. Particular attention should be paid to reasons for disqualification (DQ) as listed in these guidelines and below.
3. Entries are to be placed from **6:00 am** until **9:30 AM** on October 5, 2019. Only one exhibitor or team per garden is permitted and rose(s) **MUST** be out door grown. Judging will commence promptly at **9:45 AM** and is anticipated to conclude at approximately **12:30 PM** (or earlier) at which time the rose show will be open to the general public. The decision(s) of the judges is final. The Rose Show Committee will furnish all containers except as specifically noted in the Rose Show Schedule. Each entry must be accompanied by a securely folded ARS Entry Tag(s) completed with Section, Class, Variety and Exhibitor Name(s), address and Convention (Exhibitor) Registration Number(s). Exhibitor names must not be visible. **Both top and Bottom** portions of the ARS Entry Tag need be completed. Only Pencil, Blue or Black ink, Stamp with Blue or Black ink or Printed Black Name Labels may be used.

4. Wedging of **green floral foam** only is permitted however, an entry may be penalized if the wedging extends above the lip of the vase according to the degree of distraction.
5. With the exception of Seedlings and Sports, rose varieties exhibited must be entered under the approved exhibition name adopted by the American Rose Society as listed in any one of the following official ARS publications: Modern Roses 12 (Book and Data Base), The Official List of Approved Exhibition Names for Judges and Exhibitors, The Handbook for Selecting Roses, or Recent Registrations on the ARS web site. In instances where a variety is not listed in any of the above listed ARS publications, a listing in the **2019 Combined Rose List (CRL)** is acceptable.
6. With the exception of Challenge Classes and classes specifying multiple varieties, all roses in each class will be placed alphabetically and each variety in each class shall constitute a separate class to be judged separately. During judging, only the Rose Show Committee, Judges and Clerks will be permitted in the Rose Show Area.
7. With the exception of Seedling and Sports, all entries become the property of the Tipton County Rose Friends and will either be sold off at the conclusion of the Rose Show or donated to local hospitals and nursing homes.
8. ARS Certificates, TCRF Certificates and Cash Prizes will be awarded as set forth in the Rose Show Schedule.

#### **Reasons for Disqualification**

- a. Misnamed, Mis-classed, Mis-placed by the exhibitor, Unlabeled, Partially labeled or Mislabeled,
- b. Stem on Stem which is a specimen exhibited with a portion of the previous stem growth attached. Exception: Old Garden Roses and Shrub roses may be shown Stem on Stem but, only with one dog leg.
- c. Presence of foreign substance applied to the foliage, stem or bloom to improve the appearance of the specimen.
- d. Not disbudded. Any class calling for a one-bloom per stem specimen must be exhibited without side buds. A side bud is defined as growth emanating from a leaf axil and having sufficient maturity to display the formation of a stem with or without flower buds. The presence of one or more leaves at the leaf axil with no evidence of a stem is cause for penalization according to the degree of distraction but, not disqualification. Exception: Species, Old Garden Roses, Climbers and Shrub one bloom per stem specimens may be exhibited with side buds.
- e. An entry in violation of ARS rules or specific rules applying to this rose show.
- f. Any rose that has been entered in this show with a name that has not been recognized by the American Rose Society will be disqualified. Roses are to be exhibited with the recognized ARS exhibition name (AEN).

Entries are open only to **registered** exhibitors of the Rose Show who are ARS members of the Deep South District. Limit of one (1) entry per exhibitor per Challenge Class. Space will be assigned by lottery. Exhibitors place entries being careful not to touch or move another entry. 36" width space limitation for large roses & 18" width space limitation for small roses. All winning entries will receive TCRF Certificates and Cash Prizes.

### **Class 101. Deep South District J. Horace McFarland Memorial Trophy**

**Five (5)** Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora roses, one bloom per stem, each a different variety, at exhibition stage, shown in separate containers with separate entry tags.

**Three (3)** Floribunda Sprays, the same or different varieties, exhibited in separate containers with separate entry tags.

Entries are open only to **registered** exhibitors of the Rose Show. Limit of one entry per exhibitor per Challenge Class. Exhibitors place entries. 18” width space limitation. All winning entries will receive ARS Certificates or TCRF Certificates and Cash Prizes.

#### Section HP. Large Rose Challenge Classes

**Class 124.** Small Garden Challenge Class – Limited to those exhibitors growing fifty (50) or less total roses. **Five (5) Roses from all Classifications. One** bloom per stem or Sprays, the **same or different varieties**, shown in **one (1) container**. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 125.** Five Same or Different Large Rose Challenge Class – **Five (5)** Hybrid Tea and/or Grandiflora roses or Floribunda, one bloom per stem, the **same or different** variety, shown in **one (1) container**. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 126.** Three OGR Challenge Class – **Three (3)** OGR roses, **one bloom** per stem or **sprays**, the **same or different varieties**, Dowager and/or Victorian, shown in **separate containers**. Date of Introduction **must** appear on the entry tag above the cultivar name. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 127.** Three Shrub Challenge Class – **Three (3)** Shrub roses, **one bloom** per stem or **sprays**, the **same or different varieties**, classic or modern shrubs, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 128.** Three Polyantha Challenge Class – **Three (3)** Polyantha rose sprays, the **same or different varieties**, shown in **separate containers**. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 129.** Artist Palette Challenge Class – **Five (5)** Hybrid Tea and/or Grandiflora, Floribunda or Shrub rose blooms at exhibition stage, each a **different variety**, representative of colors used by an artist. **Exhibitors must use their own palette**. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 130.** Hi – Lo Challenge Class – **One (1)** bloom per stem Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora rose or Floribunda and **one (1)** bloom per stem Miniature or Miniflora rose matched as closely as possible for form and color shown in **separate containers**. **Cash Prize & ARS Certificate**

**Class 131.** English Box Large Rose Challenge Class – **Six (6)** Hybrid Tea and/or Grandiflora or Floribunda roses without foliage, of the **same variety** or three **different varieties** of two (2) each, at exhibition stage. **Exhibitors must use their own English Box.** Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 132.** Rose in a Bowl Challenge Class – **One (1)** Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora or Floribunda rose at exhibition stage exhibited in clear water in a bowl furnished by the TCRF. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 133.** Picture Frame Large Rose Challenge Class - **One (1)** Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora or Floribunda bloom exhibited in an 8 ½ x 11 picture frame. **Exhibitors may use their own picture frames.** Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 134.** Country Artist Theme Challenge Class – **Five (5)** roses one bloom per stem exhibited in **separate vases** with individual entry tags. Roses from Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora, Floribunda or Shrub that has a Country Artist Name or Theme in its Name or the Name of a Country Singer as the name of the rose. Cash Prize and TCRF Certificate.

## **Deep South & Tenarky District** **– Large Roses –** **Single Stem Classes**

Entries are open only to **registered** exhibitors of the Rose Show. No limit on entries per exhibitor except only one entry per exhibitor of a cultivar. Exhibitors place entries. All winning entries will receive ARS Certificates or TCRF Certificates and Cash Prizes.

### **Section HQ. Large Roses Single Stem Classes**

**Class 135.** Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora and their Climbing Counterparts – **One (1)** bloom per stem, at exhibition stage. The best **six (6)** blue ribbon winning roses are eligible for **Queen, King, Princess and Court**. Cash Prize & ARS Queen, King and Princess Certificate plus 3 TCRF Certificates

**Class 136.** Novice Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora and their Climbing Counterparts – **One (1)** bloom per stem, at exhibition stage. The best blue ribbon winner will be awarded **Novice Queen**. All Novice blue ribbon winners are eligible for **Class 135 Queen of Show**. A Novice is an exhibitor who has **NEVER** won a blue ribbon in any class at an ARS sanctioned rose show. Trophy, Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 137.** Open Bloom – **One (1)** bloom per stem Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora rose fully open with stamens showing. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 138.** Spray – **One (1)** stem Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora rose with two (2) or more blooms. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 139.** Floribunda Bloom – **One (1)** bloom per stem Floribunda at exhibition stage without side buds. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 140.** Floribunda Spray – **One (1)** stem Floribunda with two (2) or more blooms. The best **six (6)** blue ribbon winners are eligible for **Queen, King, Princess and Court**. Cash Prize & ARS Queen, King and Princess Certificate plus three (3) TCRF Certificates

**Class 141.** Polyantha Spray – **One (1)** stem Polyantha with two (2) or more blooms. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 142.** Climbers – **One (1)** stem of a Large-Flowered Climber, Hybrid Wichurana or Hybrid Gigantea with two (2) or more blooms. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 143.** Single Roses – **One (1)** stem of any type of rose (exclusive of Miniature or Miniflora) having four (4) to eight (8) petals and/or classified as a single. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 144.** Classic Shrub – **One (1)** bloom or spray from the classes of roses of Hybrid Musk, Hybrid Rugosa, Hybrid Moyesii or Kordesii. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 145.** Modern Shrub – **One (1)** Shrub Spray with two (2) or more blooms. The best **six (6)** blue ribbon winners are eligible for **Queen, King, Princess and Court.** Cash Prize & ARS Queen, King and Princess Certificate plus three (3) TCRF Certificates

**Class 146.** Old Garden Roses (**Dowager Queen**) - **One (1)** bloom or spray of an Old Garden Rose introduced before 1867 including roses of unknown dates known to have been in existence prior to 1867. Date of Introduction **must** appear above the cultivar name on the ARS Entry Tag. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 147.** Old Garden Roses (**Victorian Award**) – **One (1)** bloom or spray of an Old Garden Rose introduced in 1867 or after including roses of unknown dates known to have been in existence in 1867 or after. Date of introduction **must** appear above the cultivar name on the ARS Entry Tag. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 148.** Species Roses (**Genesis Award**) – One (1) bloom or spray of a rose designated in ARS publications as a Species Rose (Sp). Date of introduction **must** appear above the cultivar name on the ARS Entry Tag. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 149.** Seedling or Sport of Hybrid Tea, Floribunda, Grandiflora, Shrub or Old Garden Rose

An unregistered seedling or Sport hybridized or found rose by the exhibitor. Parentage is to be listed on entry tag if known. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 150.** Seedling or Sport of Miniature, Miniflora or Polyantha rose  
An unregistered seedling or sport hybridized or found by the exhibitor. Parentage is to be listed on entry tag if known. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

# **Deep South & Tenarky District – Miniature Roses – Single Stem Classes**

Entries are open only to registered exhibitors of the Rose Show.  
No limit on entries per exhibitor except only one entry per exhibitor of a  
cultivar. Exhibitors place entries. All winning entries will receive ARS  
Certificates or TCRF Certificates and Cash Prizes.

## **Section HR. Miniature Rose Single Stem Classes**

**Class 151.** Miniature – **One (1)** bloom per stem at exhibition stage. The best six (6) blue ribbon winning roses are eligible for **Queen, King, Princess and court. Cash Prize & ARS Queen, King and Princess Certificate plus three (3) TCRF Certificates**

**Class 152.** Miniature Novice - **One (1)** bloom per stem, at exhibition stage. The best blue ribbon winner will be awarded **Miniature Novice Queen**. All Miniature Novice blue ribbon winners are eligible for **Class 151 Miniature Queen of Show**. A Novice is an exhibitor who has **NEVER** won a blue ribbon in any class at an ARS sanctioned rose show. Trophy, Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 153.** Miniature Open Bloom – **One (1)** Bloom per stem of a fully open bloom with stamens showing. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 154.** Miniature Spray – **One (1)** spray with two (2) or more blooms. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 155.** Miniature Single – **One (1)** bloom classified as a single with four (4) to eight (8) petals and/or classified as a single. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

## **Deep South & Tenarky District – Miniflora Roses – Single Stem Classes**

Entries are open only to **registered** exhibitors of the Rose Show. No limit on entries per exhibitor except only one entry per exhibitor of a cultivar. Exhibitors place entries. All winning entries will receive ARS Certificates or TCRF Certificates and Cash Prizes.

### **Section HS. Miniflora Rose Single Stem Classes**

**Class 156.** Miniflora – **One (1)** bloom per stem at exhibition stage. The best six (6) blue ribbon winning roses are eligible for **Queen, King, Princess and court.** Cash Prize & ARS Queen, King and Princess Certificates plus 3 TCRF Certificates

**Class 157.** Miniflora Novice - **One (1)** bloom per stem, at exhibition stage. The best blue ribbon winner will be awarded **Miniflora Novice Queen.** All Miniflora Novice blue ribbon winners are eligible for **Class 156 Miniflora Queen of Show.** A Novice is an exhibitor who has **NEVER** won a blue ribbon in any class at an ARS sanctioned rose show. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 158.** Miniflora Open Bloom – **One (1)** Bloom per stem of a fully open bloom with stamens showing. Cash Prize & ARS Certificate

**Class 159.** Miniflora Spray – **One (1)** spray with two (2) or more blooms. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 160.** Miniflora Single – **One (1)** bloom classified as a single with four (4) to eight (8) petals and/or classified as a single. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

## **Deep South & Tenarky District – Judges Class –**

Entries are open only to those who are registered for the 2019 National Miniature Convention and Rose Show who are not exhibiting in Class 101 through and including Class 160. Limited to three (3) entries per exhibitor per class. All winning entries will receive TCRF Certificates. The **Best Entry** from Classes 161 through and including 164 will receive an ARS certificate.

### **Section HT. Judges Classes**

**Class 161.** Judges Large Rose Exhibition Class – **One (1)** bloom per stem, at exhibition stage, of Hybrid Tea, Floribunda, Shrub and OGR rose. Limit of four (4) entries per judge. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 162.** Judges Small Rose Exhibition Class – **One (1)** bloom per stem, at exhibition stage, of Miniature, Miniflora or Polyantha rose. Limit of four (4) entries per Judge. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 163** Judges Large Rose Spray Class – **One (1)** spray with two or more blooms of Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora, Floribunda, Shrub and OGR rose. Limit of four (4) entries per judge. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate

**Class 164.** Judges Small Rose Spray Class – **One (1)** spray with two or more blooms of Miniature, Miniflora or Polyantha rose. Limit of four (4) entries per judge. Cash Prize & TCRF Certificate
